What do cows get sick with?

Hay fever

Do you know that cows have around 25,000 taste buds?

That's about 2.5 times more than a human has! This is due, in part, to the fact that cows are herbivores and must be able to differentiate between the poisonous plants and the safe plants.

Additionally, did you know that cows don't have top incisor teeth? This means that they can't bite the grass with their teeth. Instead, they actually tear it from the roots by wrapping their long and **dexterous** tongue around it and closing their jaws on it.

The lower portion of the grass contains load of nutrients and fiber so it is beneficial for the cows to eat the lower portion -AND it helps for proper regrowth of the forage.
